TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Benjamin B. Rosenstock, Walter E. Sinn and William M. Storm, Receivers in the aforementioned cause, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That they have been appointed receivers by your Honorable Court in this cause and have duly qualified by the filing of their approved bond with the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in the penal sum required in the order of your Honorable Court bearing date on February fifteenth, Nineteen Hundred and Forty-four, and have duly entered upon the discharge of their duties as receivers in this cause.

SECOND: That it is necessary to give notice to the creditors of Charles F. Rothenhoefer, deceased, and of the Excelsior Sanitary Dairy, a business conducted by the said Charles F. Rothenhoefer, deceased, to file their claims in this cause in order for them to participate in the funds of the estate of Charles F.
