The Petition and Report of Sale of William J. Kelley and Charles McC. Mathias, the Trustees named in a Deed of Trust dated the 1st day of November, 1939, between The Fritchie Home Company, a body corporate of the State of Maryland and said Trustees, respectfully represents unto your Honors:

1. That on the 1st day of November, 1939, The Fritchie Home Company, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, executed its Deed of Trust to William J. Kelley and Charles McC.
