It is thereupon this 26th day of March, 1946, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity, ORDERED that notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this Order in some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks, warning all persons, known and unknown, residents and none-residents of the State of Maryland, interested in the said property to be and appear in this Court by the 28th day of May, 1946, and redeem the property located in the Woodville District, described as eighteen (18) acres of wood land, more or less, and assessed to John R. Smith and answer the Bill or thereafter a final Decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property, and vesting in the Plaintiff's a title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
