Jones, his wife, to the several lots or parcels of land hereinbefore described upon the payment of the purchase price in full for the respective lots or parcels of land, together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing subsequent to the date of sale.

And for such other and further relief as the nature and equity of their case may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto the Complainants herein an Order of Publication giving notice to Nettie VanMeter, Bessie L. Hogan and Wilbur King, parties defendants, and all persons known and unknown, having or claiming to have an interest in the property located in Petersville District, Frederick County, Maryland, and described as Lots Numbers 24, 25 and 26 in New Addition and assessed to Mrs. Nettie VanMeter; and the property described as Lot No. 1 Block 2, Fifth Avenue and assessed to Bessie L. Hogan, and the property located in Brunswick District described as Lot No. 17 as shown on the Plat of Potomac Heights, and improvements and assessed to Wilbur King, warning them and each of them to be and appear in this Court in person or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to be named therein, to answer said Bill of Complaint and redeem said property and in case of failure to do so a final Decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the foregoing property.

And also the Writ of Subpoena directed to Bessie L. Hogan, whose address is 1602 East 32nd Street, Baltimore, Maryland, and James H. Falk, Treasurer of Frederick County, Maryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear either in person or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to be named herein to answer said Bill of Complaint or to redeem said property and in case of failure to do so a final decree will be rendered.
