IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR FREDERICK COUNTY SITTING AS A COURT OF EQUITY

Howard Marvin Jones and Mabel C. Jones, his wife, Vs. Nettie VanMeter, Bessie L. Hogan, Wilbur King, James H. Falk, County Treasurer of Frederick County, and all persons having or claiming to have any interest in the following property: Lots numbers 24, 25 and 26 in New Addition in Petersville District assessed in the name of Nettie VanMeter, Lot No. 1, Block 2 Fifth Avenue in Brunswick District, assessed in the name of Bessie L. Hogan and Lot No. 17 as shown on the Plat of Potomac Heights, and improvements in Brunswick District assessed in the name of Wilbur King.

ORDER OF PUBLICATION

The object of this proceeding is to secure the foreclosure of all rights of redemption in the following properties located in Petersville and Brunswick Districts in Frederick County, Maryland, sold by the Collector of taxes for Frederick County and the State of Maryland to the Plaintiffs in this Proceeding: to-wit:

The Bill of Complaint states, amongst other things, that the amounts necessary for the redemption have not been paid although more than a year and a day from the date of sale has expired.

It is thereupon, this 4th day of June, 1946, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity, Ordered that notice be given by the insertion of this Order in some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County, once a week for four successive weeks, warning all persons known and unknown, residents and nonresidents of the State of Maryland, interested in the said properties to be and appear in this Court by the 9th day of August, 1946, and redeem the properties hereinbefore described and answer the Bill of Complaint, or thereafter a final Decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the properties and vesting in the Plaintiff's a title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
