TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:-

The Petition of Edward S. Delaplaine, Trustee, in the above-entitled proceeding, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:-

FIRST:

That your Petitioner, as Trustee, has completed his duties in the administration of the trust in this proceeding.

SECOND:

That the receipts from sales and other sources aggregated \$11,904.30.

THIRD:

That the disbursements, made by your Petitioner, as Trustee, aggregated the sum of \$10,646.27.

FOURTH:

That your Petitioner, as Solicitor, has rendered numerous legal services for the parties in interest for a period of about two years in connection with this trusteeship, including the following services:

- (A) Preparation of Petition praying the Court to assume jurisdiction of the trust.
- (B) Preparation of Petition for the sale of the Real Estate, known as the "Biser's Coal Yard", in Frederick City, Maryland; and in connection with the titles for the said real estate, and the Reports of Sales.
- (C) Preparation of Petition for the sale of all the Personal Property at the "Biser's Coal Yard", and in connection with the advertisement thereof, and Report of Sales.
- (D) Preparation of Petition for the sale of Personal Property at the Cora B. Biser property, on East Eighth Street, in Frederick City, Maryland; and other matters in connection therewith.
- (E) Preparation of Petition for ratification of private sale of Personal Property, including Farming Implements, and Motor Trucks; as well as giving Public Notices; and Notices to the parties in interest in accordance with the Orders of Your Honorable Court.
- (F) Preparation of Petition for sale of Lot in "Mottet Addition" and legal aid in connection with the title to the same; and Report of Sales.
- (G) Petitions in connection with the transfer of the North Market Street Property and the East Eighth Street Property, at private sale in pursuance of an Agreement filed in this proceeding; and giving notices to the parties in interest and public notice; and the final ratification thereof.
- (H) Attending to all other legal duties during the period of about two years, in the administration of this Trust.
- (I) That your Petitioner did also, in addition to his usual duties as Trustee, perform important and valuable service in raising the sum of SEVEN THOUSAND (\$7,000.00) DOLLARS, by obtaining a loan of \$3,000.00 on the North Market Street property, and a loan of \$4,000.00 on the East Eighth Street property, in accordance with the wishes of the parties in interest, and thus prevented the sale of both of the said properties at auction.
