THIS DEED, made this twenty eighth day of November, in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Sixty one, by Margarett Pickett, Moses Clary and Sarah Ann Clary, his wife, Reuben T. Clary and Sarah E. Clary his wife and Frederick S. Clary of Frederick County in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth, that in consideration of twelve hundred dollars, and for the purpose of conveying the reversionary interest which they have in the property herein described as heirs at law of Reuben Clary late of said County deceased, the said Margarett Pickett, Moses Clary and Sarah Ann Clary, his wife Reuben T. Clary and Sarah E. Clary his wife and Frederick S Clary, do grant unto Aaron Clary of the County and State aforesaid, all their right title and interest of and into the following parts parcels or pieces of land, situate and lying in the County aforesaid and described as follows vis: four tracts or parts
