Anna Vansant Disney, a witness of lawful age, having been first duly sworn, deposes and says:

Q. Mrs. Disney, will you state your full name and address, please.

A. Mrs. Anna Vansant Disney, 1026 Sixteenth Street, N. W., Washington, D.C. I am temporarily residing at the Washington Address, but my permanent home is in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Q. What is your age ?

A. Sixty-two.

Q. What is your occupation ?

A. Housewife.

Q. Did you know Aaron Clary in his lifetime ?

A. Yes.

Q. Was he a relative of yours ?

A. Yes, my grandfather.

Q. About when did he die ?

A. May 7, 1902.

Q. At the time of his death did he own any real estate in Frederick County ?

A. Yes.

Q. Will you state what this real estate consists of ?

A. He owned a farm containing 114 acres, more or less, located in Woodville Election District of Frederick County.

Q. Can you describe the improvements that are located on this farm, that is, what buildings are on the farm ?

A. A house and a modern dairy barn.

Q. Of what materials are the buildings constructed ?

A. Frame.

Q. The house is frame, too ?

A. Yes.

Q. I show you exhibits "Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5" filed in these proceedings, and will you state whether or not they correctly describe the real estate of which Mr. Clary died seized and possessed, located in Frederick County ?

A. Yes, I think they do.

Q. Did your Grandfather own any other real estate at the time of his death ?

A. Yes.

Q. Will you describe that property ?

A. He also owned two dwellings located in the Town of Mt. Airy, in Carroll County, Maryland.

Q. Will you describe the nature of these dwellings ?

A. They are two-story frame houses. I believe they have about six rooms in each.

Q. Are the houses now occupied ?

A. Yes.

Q. By tenants ?

A. Yes.

Q. What is the term of the tenancy ?

A. Month by month. They are occupied by Carroll Burdette, who pays \$10.00 a month rent, and by
