

(2) Charles W. Hallar, a son, whose wife's name is Mayble Hallar, both of whom are adults, residing in Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania.

(3) Elizabeth (Lizzie) Buch, a daughter, whose husband's name is Frank Buch, both of whom are adults, residing in Frederick City, Maryland.

(4) Frank Hallar, a son, whose wife's name is Mildred Hallar, both of whom are adults residing in Zanesville, Ohio.

(5) Wilson B. Hallar, a son, whose wife's name is Cathereine Hallar, both of whom are adults and reside in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

(6) Preston Hallar, a son, whose wife's name is Inez Hallar, both of whom are adults, residing in Baltimore City, Maryland.

(7) Louise Hallar Roderick, a daughter, whose husband's name is Samuel Roderick, both of whom are adults, and reside in Frederick City, Maryland.

(c) That the said Charles W. Hallar, left another daughter (not named in the deed Exhibit No. 1) whose name is Hettie Tyson, whose husband is deceased and who is an adult and resides at Chevy Chase, Maryland, who is entitled to a one-fourth interest in said real estate.

(d) That the said Charles W. Hallar, deceased, left another daughter (not named in the deed Exhibit No. 1) whose name was Alice Haller Anders, whose husband's name was _____ Anders, both of whom are dead and left a son, Charles Anders, who is also deceased, but left a widow surviving him named Mame Anders, and adult, residing in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and two children, namely:

(1) Fred Anders, a son, whose wife's name is _____ Anders, both of whom are adults residing in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

(2) Mame Anders, a daughter, whose husband's (if any) name is _____, both of whom are adults (if living), whose residence is unknown, but when last heard from, resided in Washington, in the District of Columbia.

TO THE END, THEREFORE, your Complainants pray:

(1) That a decree may be passed by your Honorable Court for a sale of the said real estate, and that a trustee or trustees may be appointed to make said sale.

(2) That the proceeds thereof may be divided between the parties to this cause according to their respective rights and interests therein.

(3) That your Oratrices and Orator may have such other and further relief as the case may require.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONORS to grant unto the Complainants the Writ of Subpoena directed to the said Elizabeth (Lizzie) Buch and Frank Buck, her husband, Louise Hallar Roderick and Samuel Roderick, her husband, all of whom are adults and reside in Frederick City, Maryland, and Preston Hallar and Inez Hallar, his wife, and Hettie Tyson (widow) an adult, of 9 East Thornapple Street, Chevy Chase, Maryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court at some certain day to be named therein and answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein; and

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONORS to grant unto Your Complainants the Order of Publication, giving notice to Charles W. Hallar and Mayble Hallar, his wife, adults, residing in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Frank Hallar and Mildred Hallar, his wife, adults, residing in Zanesville, Ohio, Wilson B. Hallar, and Catherine Hallar, his wife, adults, residing in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Mame Anders, widow, and Fred Anders, and _____ Anders, his wife, adults residing in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and Mame Anders, whose husband's name is _____, (if married), both of whom are adults, (if living) whose residence is unknown, but when last heard from, resided in Washington, in the District of Columbia, all of whom are adults and all of whom are non-residents of the State of Maryland, of the object and substance of this Bill, and warning them to be and appear in this Court, in person or by Solicitor, on or before a certain day to be named therein to
