

- Q. How long have you lived in the vicinity of Knoxville?
- A. I have kept in close contact with the community of Knoxville my entire lifetime and have lived in that community constantly since 1933.
- Q. Are you a relative of Barton V. B. Garrott?
- A. I am his son.
- Q. Is Mr. Garrott living?
- A. No.
- Q. When did he die?
- A. March of 1916.
- Q. Did he die testate or intestate?
- A. He died testate, leaving a will.
- Q. I show you a paper purporting to be a certified copy of the Last Will and Testament of Barton V. B. Garrott filed in this proceeding as Exhibit "No. 7". Will you look at the instrument and state whether or not that is a true copy of the will of Mr. Garrott?
- A. Yes, sir, that is a true copy.
(Filed as evidence.)
- Q. According to the second paragraph of this will the residue of the estate of Mr. Garrott is given to his wife, Lydia M. Garrott, and to George B. Garrott, Executors, in trust, to pay the income from the estate to Lydia M. Garrott for her own use during her natural life. Will you state whether or not Lydia M. Garrott is now living?
- A. She is not.
- Q. When did she die?
- A. June 21, 1932.
- Q. The same paragraph of the will, after the death of Lydia M. Garrott, directs that the entire property be divided among four children; George B. Garrott, Cora M. Garrott, Emily A. Garrott and Mabel B. Garrott. Will you state whether or not these four children are now living?
- A. No, Emily is not living.
- Q. Three of the children are living?
- A. Yes, three of us living.
- Q. What is the present marital status of those children that are living?
- A. Cora M. Garrott is single; Mabel Garrott Pearl was married and is now a widow; and I was married and am now a widower.
- Q. When did your sister Emily die?
- A. She died October 12, 1938.
- Q. Did she die testate or intestate?
- A. She died testate, leaving a will.
- Q. I show you a paper purporting to be a copy of the Last Will and Testament of Emily A. Garrott filed in this proceeding as Exhibit "No. 8". Will you look at the instrument and state whether or not that is the will of your sister, Emily A. Garrott?
- A. Yes, sir, that is it.
(Filed as evidence.)
- Q. Has her personal estate been fully administered?
- A. Yes.
- Q. You know of no property that she might have which has not been administered and distributed other than an interest in the farm near Knoxville?
