TO THE/JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Charles McC. Mathias, Substituted Trustee in the above entitled matter respectfully represents unto your Honors:

(1.) That among other assets in the hands of your petitioner, as Substituted Trustee in the above entitled matter, is a piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being near Lewistown in Frederick County, State of Maryland, containing 16 acres of land more or less together with the buildings and improvements thereon which is more particularly described in a Deed from Marion E. Ramsburg and Sara J.
