Boone and Ray Boone, his wife, all of whom reside in Washington County, Maryland; commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court either in person or by solicitor on some certain day to be named therein and answer the premises and abide by and perform such orders and decrees as may be passed herein.

2. And may it please Your Honors to grant unto your complainant the Order of Publication giving notice to Calvin M. Boone and Pearl Boone, his wife, Clyde D. Boone and Julia Boone, his wife, and James D. Boone and Mrs. James D. Boone, his wife, all of whom are non-residents of the State of Maryland, of the object and substance of this Bill and warning them, and each of them, to be and appear in your Honorable Court in person or by solicitor on or before a certain day to be named therein, and answer the premises and show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passes as prayed.
