EXHIBIT "A"

I, Grace Winebrener Trail, (widow), of Frederick County, State of Maryland, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do make, ordain, publish and declare this as and for my Last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, to-wit:

After the payment of all of my just debts and funeral expenses, I do give, devise and bequeath as follows:

FIRST: I give and bequeath the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to Mt. Olivet Cemetery, to invest the said named sum of money with other funds of like character and apply the income thereof, or so much as may be necessary, under the direction of the Managers of Mt. Olivet Cemetery, to the keeping in good order and condition the grounds, monuments, tombstones, etc., owned by Grace Winebrener Trail, being in Area Q, Lots Nos. 24, 25, 26 and 27, as laid out, platted and numbered by said Company.

SECOND: I have heretofore disposed of, by gift, during my lifetime, to members of my family, certain of my personal effects. And all of my personal effects which I have not disposed of during my lifetime, I give and bequeath unto my Executrices and Executor, hereinafter named, to be divided by them as equally as possible, among my daughters, Florence Trail Davidson, Theresa Trail Mathias, and Beatrice Trail Fenton, and my son, Charles Bayard Trail.

THIRD: I give and bequeath unto my daughter, Theresa Trail Mathias, the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00), in trust and confidence nevertheless, with power to invest and re-invest the same as the exigencies of the case may require, in such public or private securities, or otherwise, as she may deem best for the interest of said trust, to collect the rents and income arising therefrom, and use the same, together with such part or parts of the principal as in her judgment may be required, for the proper maintenance, support and education of my granddaughter, Theresa Trail Mathias, Jr.

FOURTH: All the rest and residue of my estate, real, personal and mixed, and I intend to include in the term rest and residue, the corpus and all accrued income of the trust estate created by the Will of my father, David C. Winebrener, by which said Will I was given the power to dispose of the corpus of said trust estate by the terms and conditions of my own last Will and Testament, and being desirous of exercising the said power so conferred, I will and direct that said corpus shall form a part of and be distributed under the residuary clause of this my will, and to that end, I do hereby direct my Executrices and Executor, hereinafter named, to divide all the rest and residue of my estate into five equal parts or portions.
