Rice, to be and appear in this Court by the 20th day of July, 1946, and redeem the property mentioned herein and answer the Bill or thereafter a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property, and vesting in the plaintiff's title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
