FINAL DECREE

This case being submitted and the proceedings therein having been read and considered by the Court:-

IT IS this 7th day of August, A.D. 1946, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, in Equity, and by the authority thereof, ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED that all rights of redemption of Charles H. Rice and all persons having or claiming to have any interest in the property located in Petersville Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, and described as five (5) acres of land, more or less, and assessed in the name of Charles H. Rice, be, and they are hereby, foreclosed from all rights of redemption in said property, and that James H. Falk, County Treasurer and Tax Collector of Frederick County, Maryland, be, and he is hereby, directed to execute a deed, in fee simple, to William R. Carter, and Emma M. Carter, his wife, and Charles H. Merryman and Mary E. Merryman, his wife, Plaintiffs, in these proceedings, and the holders of the Certificate of Sale, upon payment to the said James H. Falk, County Treasurer of Frederick County, Maryland, of the balance of the purchase price due on account of the said property, together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing subsequent to the date of sale on April 9, 1945.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a certified copy of this Decree be served upon James H. Falk, County Treasurer and Tax Collector for Frederick County, Maryland.
