TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Bill of Complaint of Carl L. Shriner and Stella Shriner, his wife, Maurice E. Shriner and Ellen M. Shriner, his wife, Mary B. Eckenrode and Henry B. Eckenrode, her husband, Vada G. Turner and David R. Turner, Jr., her husband, Harry W. Shriner, Bruce I. Shriner, unmarried, and Emmanuel D. Shriner, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court;

FIRST: That a certain Fannie M. Shriner, late of Frederick County, Maryland, died on the 27th day of January, 1945, intestate, possessed of a certain parcel of land situate, lying and being in Frederick County, Maryland, and being the same parcel of land that descended to and vested in her upon the death of her son, Annan C. Shriner, who died in July, 1944, intestate. Said parcel of land being more fully described in a deed from Fannie M. Shriner and Cornelius Shriner, her husband, dated December 8, 1938, and recorded in Liber No. 414, folio 468, one of the Land Records for Frederick County, a certified copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 1 to this Bill of Complaint.

SECOND: That the said Fannie M. Shriner, at the time of her death, left the following heirs at law, to whom said property descended to and vested in by virtue of the inheritance laws of the State of Maryland, as tenants in common, to-wit:

Carl L. Shriner, a son, whose wife's name is Stella Shriner and who reside at Thurmont, Maryland.

Maurice E. Shriner, a son, whose wife's name is Ellen M. Shriner, and who reside at Thurmont, Maryland.

Mary B. Eckenrode, a daughter, whose husband's name is Henry B. Eckenrode, Jr., and who reside at Rocky Ridge, Maryland.

Vada G. Turner, a daughter, whose husband's name is David R. Turner, Jr., and who reside at Friend's Creek, Frederick County, Maryland.

Harry W. Shriner, a son, whose wife's name is Caroline Shriner, and who reside at Thurmont, Maryland.

Bruce I. Shriner, a daughter, unmarried, who resides at Hanover, State of Pennsylvania

Emmanuel D. Shriner, a son, in the service of the United States, whose wife's name is Teeve Shriner, and who resides at Mt. Savage, Allegany County, Maryland.

Edith Clabaugh, a deceased daughter (predeceased her mother), who left the following children:

Lulu Clabaugh Yingling, whose husband's name is Roy Yingling and who reside at Thurmont, Frederick County, Maryland.

Grace Clabaugh Wolfe, whose husband's name is Sidney Wolfe, and who reside at Sabillasville Frederick County, Maryland.

Roy Clabaugh, unmarried, who resides at Thurmont, Maryland.

Russell Clabaugh, infant, who resides at Thurmont, Maryland.

THIRD: That said real estate is incapable of division amongst the parties entitled according to their respective interests without loss and injury, and it would be to the benefit and advantage of all the parties in interest that same to sold and the proceeds arising therefrom be distributed according to the interests of the respective parties.

TO THE END, THEREFORE,

1st. That a Decree may be passed for the sale of the said real estate by a Trustee or Trustees to be appointed by your Honorable Court, and the proceeds arising therefrom be dis-
