THIS DEED made this 5th day of December in the year A.D. 1914, by us, Susan A. Hood and Samuel W. Hood of Howard County, State of Maryland, Witnesseth;- That for and in consideration of the sum of ONE HUNDRED dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the said Susan A. Hood and Samuel W. Hood do hereby grant and convey unto Charles S. Brown and Sallie Bronw, his wife, as tenants by entireties of Frederick County, State of Maryland, all that lot or parcel of ground situate, lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, and described as follows, Being part of a tract of land situate in Sugar Loaf Mountain and conveyed to George W. Peters of said County by Eliza Armstrong by deed dated the 3rd of April 1888 and recorded in Liber W.I.P. No. 5, folio 117 as lot No. 4 in said deed Beginning for the part to be hereby conveyed at the end of 2-8/10 perches on the second line of lot No. 4 as described in the 2nd part of said deed and running thence with said 2nd line correcting the same to agree with the original location thereof South 56-3/3° East 23-6/10 perches to a stone, then with the 3rd line thereof correcting as before South 8-1/2° East 22 perches to a stake in a pile of stone then by the compass North 87 1/4° West 28-15/100 perches to a stake now planted on the East side of an old road and on the 5th line of Lot No. 4 at the end of 69 perches thereon and 2-2/10 perches reversed on the said 5th line from a stone at the end thereof then with by the compass North 13° East 17 perches North 4° East 16 1/2 perches to the beginning in fee simple containing three acres three roods and thirty-four square perches of land clear 5-9/10 square perches off land in the bed of an old road ten feet wide as it runs across the Northwest corner of the within described piece of land and leads from the lot formerly owned _____ Robert Roberts to the place formerly owned by George E. House and which road bed ten feet wide is hereby excepted from this conveyance and not included in said 3 acres, 3 roods and 34 square perches of land, more or less, The land hereby conveyed being the same land conveyed by George W. Peters to Susan A. Hood by deed dated the 25th day of May, 1892, and recorded in Liber J.L.J. No. 7, folio 237, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, reference thereto being had will more fully and at large appear.
