 TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Bill of Complaint of John H. Danner and Lucretia Danner, his wife, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That Thomas L. Danner, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, died intestate on or about the 14th day of January, 1934, seized and possessed of certain lots or parcels of land, situate, lying and being in Petersville Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, improved with a two-story, six-room frame house and other outbuildings, containing in the aggregate approximately 1 3/4 acres of land; being all and the same real estate which was conveyed unto the said Thomas L. Danner by deeds from Charles F. Macklin and Emily S. Macklin, his wife, dated April 24, 1907, and February 5, 1913, and recorded, respectively, in Liber S.T.H. No. 280, Folio 201, and Liber H.W.B. No. 308, Folio 1, Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, certified copies of which said deeds are filed herewith as "Exhibits Nos. 1" and "2", respectively, and are prayed may be taken and considered a part hereof.

2. That the said Thomas L. Danner left surviving him as his only known heirs-at-law:

(A) His widow, the late Anna Danner, who died testate on or about the 11th day of December, 1935, and by the terms and provisions of her Last Will and Testament, duly admitted to probate by the Orphans Court for Frederick County and recorded in Liber J.H. No. 1, Folio 7, one of the Will Records of the County aforesaid, a certified copy of which said Will is filed herewith as "Exhibit No. 3" and is prayed may be taken and considered a part hereof, directed that her real estate be sold and the proceeds thereof divided equally "between my sister and my two brothers, namely, Sarah Marquette, Frank Garber and Samuel K. Garber"; that the said Sarah Marquette departed this life on or about the 16th day of July, 1935, leaving a Last Will and Testament duly admitted to probate by the Orphans Court for Frederick County, Maryland, and recorded in Liber M.F.S. No. 1, Folio 526, one of the Will Records for said County, a certified copy of which said Will is filed herewith as "Exhibit No. 4" and is prayed may be taken and considered a part hereof, and by the provisions of said Will said Testatrix devised all of her property "of every kind and description, real, personal and mixed, and wheresoever situated, to my three children, to-wit: John Marquette, Camille E. Magalis and Hamore V. Marquette, share and share alike; that the said Frank Garber, Samuel K. Garber, John Marquette, Camille E. Magalis and Hamore V. Marquette are all residents of Frederick County, Maryland.

(B) That the said Thomas L. Danner left surviving him the following heirs by a brother, Joshaway Danner, late of Frederick County, Maryland, the said Joshaway Danner having predeceased the said Thomas L. Danner intestate leaving surviving him:

(1) A son, William Danner, late of Loudoun County, Virginia, deceased, whose wife's name was Susan L. Danner, also deceased, the said William Danner having departed this life intestate prior to the demise of Thomas L. Danner leaving surviving him the following children, to-wit: A daughter, Elva M. Fauble, residing at Weaverton, Washington County, Maryland; a daughter, Mary Toleda Danner, a daughter, Louise Miller, both residing at Peonian Springs, Virginia; a daughter, Amata Bell Putman, residing at Cool Springs, Virginia; a son, John
