THIS DEED made this 24th day of April in the year Nineteen Hundred and Seven, by us, Charles F. Macklin and Emily S. Macklin, his wife, of Howard County, in the State of Maryland, as parties of the first part and Thomas L. Danner of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, as parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH that in consideration of the premises and the sum of Three Hundred Sixty Seven Dollars and Fifty cents (\$367.50), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties of the first part do grant in fee simple unto the said Thomas L. Danner parties of the second part, the following described lot or parcel of land, situate in Frederick County, State of Maryland, lying near the village of Knoxville, in said County and on the west side thereof, the lot hereby conveyed being a part of the Macklin lands in said County, and lying north of the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad Company's lands.
