Danner intestate leaving surviving a son, Raymond Carey, a daughter, Gladys Carey Lewis, both of whom reside at Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland; a daughter, Mabel Carey Onberko, and a son, Howard Carey, both of whom reside at McKeesport, Pennsylvania, and a daughter Lillian Carey Smith, whose last known address was Brooklyn, Maryland, but whose present address is unknown to your Complainants.

(4) That the said Sarah E. Carey also left surviving her a son, John T. Carey, whose wife's name is Mary E. Carey, the said John T. Carey having predeceased the said Thomas L. Danner intestate leaving surviving a daughter, Lacey Powers, a daughter, Ida Shafer, a son, John T. Carey, Jr., a son, Joseph Carey, a son, Harvey M. Carey, a son, Charles V. Carey, and a daughter, Mabel V. Bowers, all of whom are residents of Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland.

(5) That the said Sarah E. Carey also left surviving her a daughter, Sarah Lakin, whose husband's name was Charles E. Lakin, and who died intestate on or about the 6th day of June, 1940, the said Sarah Lakin having died intestate at Arlington, Virginia, on or about the 2nd day of December, 1939, leaving surviving a daughter, Mattie Voith, a daughter, Mary L. French, and a son, Charles W. Lakin, all of whom are residents of Boston, Massachusetts.

(6) That the said Sarah E. Carey also left surviving her a son, Michael Carey, whose wife's name was Bessie Carey, both of whom are deceased, the said Michael Carey having predeceased the said Thomas L. Danner intestate leaving surviving a son, Lawrence Carey, a son, Lester Carey, both of whom are residents of the City of Washington, District of Columbia, and a son, Michael Carey, whose last known address was Sparrow's Point, Baltimore Maryland, but whose present place of residence is unknown to your Complainants.

(D) That Jacob Danner, a brother of Thomas L. Danner, predeceased the said Thomas L. Danner leaving surviving a wife, Lizzie Danner, now residing at Montevue, Frederick County, Maryland, but no children were born of said marriage.

(E) That the said Thomas L. Danner left surviving him the following heirs by his sister, Harriet Ann Barger, whose husband's name was William Barger, both of whom are now deceased, the said Harriet Ann Barger having predeceased the said Thomas L. Danner intestate leaving surviving a son William P. Barger, residing at Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, and a daughter, Della Turner, residing at Burkittsville, Frederick County, Maryland.
