TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Amended Bill of Complaint of John H. Danner and Lucretia Danner, his wife, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That since the filing of the original Bill of Complaint in this cause on the 15th day of August, 1940, your Complainants have been credibly advised and informed and, therefore, aver that in addition to the several heirs-at-law which the said Thomas L. Danner left surviving by a brother, Ezra Danner, as set forth in paragraph 2 (F) of said original Bill of Complaint are the following children of Samuel Danner, deceased, a son of the late Ezra Danner, deceased, the said Samuel Danner having predeceased the said Thomas L. Danner leaving surviving three sons, to-wit: Raymond Danner, Norman Danner and Frank Danner, all adult residents of Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland; and also the only children of George Danner, deceased, a son of the said Ezra Danner, the said George Danner having predeceased the said Thomas L. Danner, intestate, leaving a daughter, Inez King, now an adult resident of Baltimore City, Maryland.
