Q. Will you relate the heirs-at-law and next of kin which Thomas L. Danner left surviving.

A. Mr. Danner was survived by his widow, Anna Danner. He had no children but was survived by a brother and decedents of brother and sisters. Joshaway Danner was a brother of Mr. Thomas Danner by forty years. To the best of my knowledge and information, he died intestate and was survived by a son, William Danner, who formerly lived in Loudoun County, Virginia, who also died prior to Thomas L. Danner intestate, leaving the following children as his heirs-at-law; a daughter, Elva M. Fauble, who now lives at Weverton, Washington County, Maryland; another daughter, Mary Toleda Danner, who has since married a Cooper, who lives at Peonian Springs, Virginia; another daughter, Louise Miller, who lives at Peonian Springs, Virginia; another daughter, Amata Bell Putman, who lives at Cool Springs, Virginia; a son, John William J. Danner; another son, Charles I. Danner; another daughter, Bessie C. Dutrow; a son, Harry Thomas Danner; a son, Levin F. Danner; a son, Oliver N. Danner; and a son, Lester Danner, all living at Lovettsville, Virginia. Joshaway Danner was also survived by a daughter, Lizzie Holmes, whose husband's name was Edward Holmes, both of these parties having died prior to Thomas L. Danner, according to the information which I have received, they died intestate, and left surviving a son, John Holmes; a daughter, Mary Ann Fields; and a son, William Holmes, all of whom reside at Lovettsville, Virginia; and another son, Jesse Holmes, whose last known address was Hagerstown, Washington County, Maryland. Mr. Joshaway Danner also left surviving him a daughter, named Kate Tatterson, whose husband's name was Edward Tatterson, both having predeceased Thomas L. Danner, and according to my information, died, intestate, leaving one son, Edward Tatterson, who resides at Harpers Ferry, West Virginia. Mr. Joshway Danner also was survived by another son, Joseph Danner, who now lives at Knoxville, Maryland. Mr. Joshaway Danner also left surviving a son, Oliver Danner, whose wife's name was Katie Danner, but Oliver Danner died prior to Mr. Thomas Danner, and according to my information he left no Will. Oliver Danner was survived by his son, Harold Danner; a daughter, Winifred Danner; and another daughter, May Danner, all of whom now reside in Washington D.C.

Mr. Thomas Danner also left surviving certain heirs-at-law by his sister, Sarah E. Carey, who was married to Michael Carey, both of whom died prior to Mr. Thomas Danner, and according to my information that died intestate. Sarah Carey was survived by a son, William P. Carey who died intestate on or about May 15, 1937. This was after Mr. Thomas Danner died. William P. Carey left surviving a widow, named Minnie B. Carey, and a son, named William L. Carey, both of whom live at Knoxville, Mr. Carey also left surviving a grandson, named Gottfried Salow, who was a son of a deceased daughter, named Mary Salow, and whose husband's name was Richard Salow. According to my information, both Mary and Richard Salow died intestate prior to Thomas L. Danner's death. The last known address of Gottfried Salow was Walter Reed Hospital, Washington, D.C. Mrs. Sarah E. Carey also was survived by a daughter, Mary Ann Dunn, whose husband's name was John Dunn. Mrs. Mary Dunn died more than ten years ago intestate, which was prior to the death of Mr. Thomas L. Danner. She was survived by a son, William Dunn, who now lives at Brunswick, Maryland; a daughter, named Julia, who was unmarried and who died intestate on September 13, 1939; and was further survived by another daughter, whose name is Mary E. Barker, who lives at Brunswick, Maryland; and a son, John Dunn, Jr., whose last known address was Louisville, Kentucky; another son, Raymond Dunn, who is now located at Brunswick, Maryland; and a daughter, Nellie G. Nelson, who also lives at Brunswick, Maryland. Mrs. Sarah E. Carey also left surviving her a son, whose name was James E. Carey, and whose wife's name was Ellia Carey, both of whom died prior to Thomas L. Danner, and, according to my information, they died intestate, leaving surviving a son, Ray-
