Miller, and into her hands only, from time to time, the interests, rents and income accruing and arising from said trust, for the comfortable maintenance, use and benefit, support and general welfare of my said daughter, for and during the period of her natural life &c., -----

4th. That the estate consists of some \$8,000.00 or \$9,000.00 cash in bank, Two-two story houses situate on East Third Street Frederick Md, which rent for \$18.00 each per month; Two-story house situated on North Market St. Frederick, Barber shop below renting for \$35.00 per month and the dwelling part for \$25.00 per month. Also the Residence of the deceased, situated on N. Market Street Frederick, the same being a two story building, where the daughter Minnie E. Miller now resides, said property being of the estimated value of some \$12,000 to \$15,000. All of said real estate being of the value of about \$30,000.00.

5th. That the said Elizabeth Miller left no debts, and the amounts in cash will more than pay the legacies and expenses, and leave a surplus. That the said Minnie E. Miller, is now in need of money for her maintenance and support. And the said Frederick A. Miller Jr., is a Junior at College, and is very much in need of funds for the coming year to meet his expenses at College, his Farther being dead, and his mother has not sufficient funds to meet his expenses at said College. That the Executrices will not file their First Account until January 1928, and said beneficiaries will not be able to receive any income from that source until that time. Your Petitioner therefore prays for the following relief.

(1) That your Honorable Court will assume jurisdiction of the Trust created under the terms of the Will of the said Elizabeth Miller, herein.

(2) And your Petitioner prays for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.
