1st. (1) That this Court will assume Jurisdiction in the premises, and cause such notice to be given by publication in such paper or papers, and for such time as it may seem proper, and that your petitioner may be released and discharged as trustee as aforesaid from the future execution of said trust.

(2) That your Petitioner may have such other and further relief as the nature of his case may require.
