

30- That the trust estate created in the aforesaid Will will cease upon the statement of the account therein in this cause, and the surplus thereof, after the payment of the aforesaid debts and the expenses incident to said trust, will vest in the said Frederick A. Miller, Jr., by virtue of the inheritance laws of the State of Maryland., he being the only grandchild of the said Elizabeth Buesing Miller, and being her next kin and only heir at law, and also being the next of kin and only heir at law of the said Minnie E. Miller.

WHEREFORE your Petition, the substituted Trustee in said cause, prays:

(1) That the \$10,000.00 trust fund created in the last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Buesing Miller for the benefit of the said Frederick A. Miller, Jr., may be designated and set apart by this Honorable Court.

(2) That your Petitioner, the substituted Trustee herein, may be authorized and empowered to sell, at private or public sale, subject to the approval of this Honorable Court, to the highest and best bidder, the real estate known and designated at Nos. 225 and 227 North Market Street, in Frederick City, Maryland; and also to sell the two \$1,000.00 Arundel Mortgage Bond Certificates, upon such terms and conditions as the Court may prescribe, and to pay from the proceeds thereof the aforesaid bills and expenses incident to said trust.

(3) And that the papers in said cause may be referred to the Auditor of this Honorable Court to state an account.

(4) And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.
