

own maintenance and the maintenance, support and education of my children from my present marriage, until such of them as shall survive me shall respectively attain the age of twenty-five years. It is then my will and I so direct that as each of my children from my present marriage respectively attain the age of twenty-five years that shall receive absolutely, from my trustee hereinafter named, one-half of their respective equal shares in two-thirds of the corpus of my estate.

It is further my will and I so direct, that when my said children from my present marriage shall have respectively attained the age of thirty years, then it is my will and I so direct that my trustee hereinafter named shall pay over to said children absolutely the remaining one-half of their respective equal shares in two-thirds of the corpus of my estate.

It is further my will and I so direct that my said wife, Grace Gordon Sappington, shall continue to receive the income on the whole corpus of my estate less such bequeaths hereinbefore made absolutely to my children, and that she shall continue to receive the income on the remaining one-third of the corpus of my said estate for and during her natural life.

It is further my will and I do direct, that upon the death of my said wife, Grace Gordon Sappington, the said trust shall cease and terminate, and the corpus thereof shall be divided equally among the children of my present marriage or their heirs.

I further authorize, empower and direct the Central Trust Company of Maryland, the Executor and Trustee herein named, to sell and convey any part or portion or all of my property, and to invest and reinvest the proceeds therefrom as in its judgment shall be deemed best in order to best promote the interests of my estate and carry out the terms and conditions of this my last will and testament and the trust hereinbefore created.

And lastly I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint the Central Trust Company of Maryland to be the Executor of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills by me heretofore made, and ratifying and confirming this and none other as and for my last will and testament.
