TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Benjamin B. Rosenstock, Trustee in this cause, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That among the other assets constituting the corpus of this estate there is a farm containing One hundred and Twenty-five (125) acres of land, more or less, situate in Liberty District, Frederick County, State of Maryland on the county road leading from Liberty to Maplebille in said county, tenanted by a certain Joseph Horton, and that said premises are improved with a stone mension house and a stone tenant house that are not furnished with electricity at present.

SECOND: That The Potomac Edison Company is willing to furnish electric service to these properties provided they are given permission to erect their transmission line beginning at the southeast corner of the aforesaid tract of land and running within the same parallel with the county road, thence at right angles to the same to a pole west of the dwelling house, thence to another pole along the fence-line near the barn, thence to another pole south of the tenant house and thence to still another pole near the southwest corner of the aforesaid tract close to the west side of the county road, as will more fully appear by the blue print hereto attached and prayed to be considered as a part hereof.

THIRD: That the installation of the aforesaid power line will be of benefit to this estate.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that he be authorized and empowered to execute the right of way agreement with the aforesaid The Potomac Edison Company, a body corporate, giving them permission to erect the power line aforesaid.
