TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of W. Jerome Offutt and Alton Y. Bennett, Trustees in the above entitled cause, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court.

FIRST: That on the 19th day of August, 1946, your Honorable Court appointed your Petitioners, Trustees to convey the interest of the infants in the real estate mentioned in these proceedings to George O. Sprigg and A. Josephine Sprigg, his wife, upon the payment of the purchase price of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00), after having duly filed a Corporate Bond of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

SECOND: That said Order further provided that upon the execution of said Deed and receipt of the money for the same, the said money was to be brought to Court to be administered and distributed subject to the Order of your Honorable Court.

THIRD: That your Petitioners have complied with the Court's Order and has on hand the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00).

FOURTH: That the following are charges against the proceeds in said cause:

A. Y. Bennett and W. J. Offutt, Solicitor's fee - Noah E. Cramer and Son, Bond premium - \$10.00 - Ellis C. Wachter, Clerk's taxes costs \$40.80.

FIFTH: That the said infant children in these proceedings are Patricia May Stonesifer, 19 years of age and the said Robbie Helen Stonesifer, 16 years of age having been born on June 17, 1930.

SIXTH: That pursuant to Section 7 of Article 79 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, the said Patricia May Stonesifer is entitled to receive her respective share of the proceeds of the sale of real estate upon executing a release acknowledged before an officer authorized to take acknowledgement of Deeds.

SEVENTH: That your Petitioners further represents that the said infant, Robbie Helen Stonesifer, by reason of infancy can not receive and execute a release for her distributive share of the proceeds from the said sale of real estate and are advised that they may pay over the sum representing the distributive share of the said infant, Robbie Helen Stonesifer, unto the Orphans' Court for Frederick County, said sum to be administered by said Court until said infant attains her majority.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

1. That this proceedings may be referred to the Auditor to state an account.
2. That your Peitioners may be authorized and directed to pay over to the Orphans' Court for Frederick County, the share of Robbie Helen Stonesifer as may be allowed and distributed in the audit to be stated, and that said sum be administered by said Court until the said infant shall have attained her majority.
