2. That the said Alicw E. Luhn is possessed of approximately \$1000 on deposit in the Farmers Banking and Trust Company of Montgomery County, Poolesville Branch and is seized and possessed of a farm in Montgomery, Maryland near Dickerson containing about 96 acres of land of the value of approximately \$5,000..

3. That said Alice E. Luhn is the widow of George C. Luhn and has no direct descendants, her nearest next of kin and heirs at law are a niece Katherine L. Thomas, wife of your Petitioner, John A. Luhn a nephew of the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland who had be judged, incompetent, and the heirs of a deceased nephew McLean Luhn, the named of all his heirs are not exactly known to your petitioner at this time.

4. That there is no person authorized to manage, care for and control the property of the said Alice E. Luhn or to care for her person.

5. That your petitioner is a resident of the County of Frederick, State of Maryland and is of full age.

To the end, therefore;

a. That a committee or trustee be appointed to take care of the person and manage the property of the said Alice E. Luhn, a person incompetent by reason of mental disability.

b. And for such further and other relief as the nature of the case may require.
