

7. Which of said sons are living?

A. Harry W. Barrick and Grover E. Barrick, George Dix Barrick, died in December 1933 and left surviving him, a widow and five children, who reside in Baltimore, and my husband, Morris V. Barrick, died on September 20, 1942, and left surviving him, his widow and one daughter, Marian A. Barrick.

8. Did Charles J. Barrick, own any real estate at the time of his death?

A. Yes. He owned a farm of 269-3/4 acres, near Rocky Ridge in Frederick County, Maryland, which has been operated since his death, by his son Harry W. Barrick.

9. Can this real estate be divided amongst the parties in interest?

A. No. There is one set of buildings and it would not be practicable to divide it amongst the parties.

10. What in your opinion would be a fair price for the farm?

A. I think fifty dollars per acre would be reasonable price for the farm.
