

the following courses, to wit: North 15 degrees East 24 perches, North 3 degrees, West 64 perches, North 12 degrees, West 13½ perches, thence South 68 degrees West 178 perches to a stone planted at the end of 72 perches on the eighth line of 218 acres and 31 perches of land, which is composed of several pieces or parcels of land, and which were conveyed by the Executors of Richard Potts to R. Potts, by deed dated on or about the 8th day of February, in the year 1812, and with said 218 acres and 31 perches of land reversed, the four following courses, to wit; South 72 perches to a planted stone, South 81¼ degrees, west 29 perches to a planted stone, North 83 degrees west 60 perches to a planted stone, South 57.6 perches to a stone planted in the road commonly called "The Fulling Mill Road", then running down and in the said road South 81 degrees East 119 and 3/10 perches to a stone planted at the end of the second line of the aforesaid three acres and seventy-three perches tract of "Spring Garden", and part of "Stoner's Lock", then with the given line thereof, South 84 3/4 degrees, East 63½ perches to a stone planted at the end of the twenty-eight line of Belle View aforesaid, then with the twenty-ninth line thereof South 54½ degrees East 70 perches, to the first mentioned place of beginning, containing two hundred and twenty-nine and three-quarters acres and thirty perches of land, more or less. It being the same real estate which was conveyed unto Joseph E. Staley and Clara A. Staley, his wife, by Charles A. Buxton, et al, by deed dated March 30, 1911, and recorded in Liber 296, folio 144, one of the Land Records of Frederick, And being the same real estate which was conveyed unto the said Oscar L. Staley by Charles A. Staley, et al, by deed of even date herewith, intended to be recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County, prior to or simultaneously with the recording of these presents.

TOGETHER with all and singular the buildings, improvements, rights, ways, privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
