To the Honorable the Judges of said Court:

The report of Holden S. Felton, Amos A. Holter and Jacob Rohrback, Trustees, appointed by a decree of this Court, passed in the above-entitled cause, dated the 30 day of December, 1943, to make sale of certain real estate therein mentioned, respectfully shows:

That after giving bond with security for the faithful performance of their trust, and after having complied with all the other prerequisites, as required by law and the said decree, and giving notice of the time, place, manner and terms of sale by advertisement inserted in the "Frederick News" and "The Frederick Post," two daily newspapers published in Frederick County, Maryland, for at least three weeks prior to the day of sale, as will appear by the Printer's Certificate filed herewith as "Exhibit P.C." and prayed to be taken as a part hereof, they did, pursuant to said notice, attend at the Court House in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, on the 22 day of January, in the year 1944, at 10 o'clock A.
