

5. That the said Laura V. Barnes departed this life intestate on November 24, 1928, and some of her heirs are non-residents of the State of Maryland.

TO THE END, THEREFORE:

1. That a final decree may be passed by your Honorable Court foreclosing all rights of redemption of the defendants herein in and to the property herein referred to, and that the County Treasurer of Frederick County, Maryland, be directed to prepare and execute a deed, in fee simple, to Russell R. Reaver and Charles E. Schellar, the plaintiffs herein, upon payment by them of the purchase price of the property in full, together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing subsequent to the date of sale.

2. And for such other and further relief as may be requisite.

May it please Your Honors to grant unto the plaintiffs herein the Order of Publication giving notice to all persons having or claiming to have any interest in the property located in Linganore District, Frederick County, Maryland, containing seven acres of wood land, and assessed in the name of Laura V. Barnes, commanding them and each of them to appear in this Court on or before a certain day to be named therein not less than sixty days from the time of the filing of this Bill of Complaint, and answer said Bill of Complaint or redeem the said property, and warning them and each of them that upon their failure to do so a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all right of redemption in the said property; and also the Writ of Subpoena directed to the said James H. Falk, County Treasurer of Frederick County, Maryland, commanding him to be and appear in this Court either in person or by solicitor on or before a certain day to be named therein, not less than sixty days from the time of the filing of this Bill of Complaint, and answer said Bill of Complaint or show cause if any he has why a decree should not be passed as prayed.
