It is thereupon this 2nd day of July, nineteen hundred and forty-five, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, in Equity, ordered that notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this Order in some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week for four successive weeks, giving notice to all persons having or claiming to have any interest in the property located in Linganore District, Frederick County, Maryland, containing seven acres of wood land, and assessed in the name of Laura V. Barnes, and warning them to be and appear in this Court by the 4th day of September, nineteen hundred and forty-five, and redeem the said property and answer the said Bill of Complaint, or thereafter a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the said property, and vesting in the plaintiffs a title free and clear of all encumbrances.
