SIXTH: That all of the above mentioned heirs at law of the said Lydia A. Cutsail and devisees of James H. Cutsail are adults, except, Bernice Horman and Phyllis Horman.

SEVENTH: That all of the said real estate mentioned and described in this Bill of Complaint is not susceptible of partition without material loss and injury to the parties entitled to interests therein, as above stated, and that in order to make a division of said interests, it will be necessary and it will then be to the best interests of all parties concerned therein, that the said real estate be sold and the proceeds thereof be divided among the parties entitled thereto, according to their respective interests therein.

TO THE END, THEREFORE,

1st. That a decree may be passed by your Honorable Court for the sale of said real estate mentioned in the foregoing Bill of Complaint and the proceeds distributed under the direction of your Honorable Court to the parties entitled according to their respective interest.

2nd. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.
