This "Deed" made this first day of December 1885 by James E. McKenzie and Teresa his wife of Frederick County Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of one hundred and forty two dollars we the said James E. McKenzie and wife, do sell and convey unto John Jacob Main of the County and State aforesaid a certain piece or parcel of land, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, it being part of a tract of land known as the Ezra Hildebrand farm. Beginning for the part hereby conveyed, at a large stone standing near the Branch called little tuscarora, and marked B. F. H. 1746 and running thence S 15 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 23 perches, East 2 perches, S 52 E 28 perches to a stone N 89 $\frac{3}{4}$ W 30 $\frac{4}{10}$ perches to a stone now planted near a locust tree, then N. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 40 perches to the beginning containing two acres two Roods and thirty-two perches of land more or less
