

- Q. What is your occupation?
- A. Well I am working for Bowers Lumber Yard.
- Q. Who was your father?
- A. James E. McKenzie.
- Q. Is he living?
- A. No, sir.

- Q. Did your father leave a Will?

- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Is she living?
- A. No, sir.
- Q. When did she die?
- A. December 24th, 1942.
- Q. Was your father survived by any children other than yourself?
- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Name them please.
- A. William; John; Daniel; James L., now dead; Mary, now dead; Clara; now dead; Joseph S., and Charles A.
- Q. Are you married?
- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. State your wife's name. A. Sadie.
- Q. Is your brother William married? A. Yes, sir.
- Q. What is his wife's name? A. Alice.
- Q. Is your brother John married? A. Yes, sir.
- Q. What is his wife's name? A. Rosie.
- Q. Is your brother Daniel married? A. Yes, sir.
- Q. What is his wife's name? A. Orpha.
- Q. At the time of your brother, James' death, was he married?
- A. What is his wife's name? A. Clara.
- Q. Did he leave surviving him any children?
- A. Yes, sir. Theresa who is married to William Hahn; Bertha who is not married, Harry who is not married, James who is married, but I do not recall his wife's name, and Helen who is married to Floyd Kreh.
