- Q. Is your brother Joseph married? A. Yes, sir.
- Q. What is his wife's name? A. Amy.
- Q. Is your brother Charles married? A. No, sir.
- Q. Did your brother, James, leave a Will? A. No, sir.
- Q. Did either of your sisters, Mary or Clara, leave a Will?
- A. No, sir.
- Q. When did your brother James die? A. September 6, 1937.
- Q. When did Clara die? A. July 16th, 1937.
- Q. When did Mary die? A. She died about the 20th day of July 1942.
- Q. What is your brother William's address?
- A. He lives in Frederick County - R.F. D. 4.
- Q. Where does your brother John reside?
- A. He lives in Frederick County.
- Q. Where does your brother Daniel reside?
- A. He lives on route 5, Frederick County, and my brother Charles lives with him, and works at Hood College.
- Q. Where does your brother's wife, Clara, and her children reside?
- A. Clara, Bertha, and Helen live in Frederick. Theresa Hahn lives in Baltimore, Maryland, and the two boys, James and Harry are in the Armed Forces, before they went in, Harry resided in Frederick, and James lived at Monrovia, Maryland.
- Q. Where does Ray Burrier, your sister Mary's child, reside?
- A. in Frederick County, Rocky Springs.
- Q. You testified as to where your sister, Clara's family resides?
- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Your brother Joseph resides at -
- A. Frederick, Route 3, Mt. Airy.
- Q. Are all of the parties to this proceeding of legal age?
- A. All except Lorene Harne.
- Q. How old is she?
- A. About 13 years old.
- Q. At the time of your father's death did he own any real estate?
- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Will you describe what it was?
- A. Well 71 or 67 acres, which ever the deed calls for, and an 11 acre mountain lot.
- Q. What district are the properties located in?
- A. Tuscarora.
- Q. In what part, are they near any particular town?
- A. Near Edgewood.
- Q. What road are they located on.
- A. 4th Street, or Rocky Springs Road, about one or one and one-half miles from High Knob.
- Q. I will show you copies of four feeds - you know that your father conveyed away part of the property - filed as exhibits in this proceeding, and ask you if they correctly describe the property.
- A. Well the home place was conveyed to him by Andrew Heller and wife, and the mountain lot he got from Neighbours, and others.
- Q. That is right.
