

at-law as above mentioned.

3. That your Orators are informed, believe and so aver that the said David P. Flook left no personal estate, and hence there is no money available for the payment of the debts and obligations of the said David P. Flook as well as funeral expenses attending his burial except the real estate aforementioned.

TO THE END, THEREFORE:

(1) That the said real estate of the said David P. Flook may be sold for the payment of the debt aforesaid, and any other debts of the said decedent, and that the proceeds of sale may be distributed unto the creditors of the said David P. Flook.

(2) And for such other and further relief as the nature and equity of their case may require.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONORABLE COURT to grant unto your Orators the writ of subpoena directed against Mollie Frances Flook, Ethel M. Davis and Earman Davis, her husband, Edgar D. Flook and Ruth G. Flook, his wife, of Frederick County, Maryland; and Roy H. Flook and Vada Flook, his wife, of Washington County, Maryland; and an order of publication against Clifford Kesselring and Clifford J. Kesselring, infant, who are non-residents of the State of Maryland, warning them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before a certain day to be named therein to show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as herein prayed.
