ORDER OF COURT

The foregoing Bill of Complaint and Affidavit of the Complainants thereto, having been read and considered by the Court.

It is thereupon this 17th day of May, 1951, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity, ORDERED, that the Writ of Subpoena be issued by the Clerk of this Court, directed to James H.
