The Bill of Complaint of Harry T. Anders, widower, Emma Bottrill and Arthur Bottrill, her husband, Paul D. Schildt and Edna M. Schildt, his wife, Melvin Schildt and Mary Schildt, his wife, Charles M. Schildt and Merle Schildt, both unmarried, Maud Wagner Smith and Vernon Smith, her husband, Leila Bartgis Carl, divorced, Grace M. Bartgis, divorced, Kenneth Bartgis and Ethel G. Bartgis, his wife, George D. Bartgis, unmarried, Carrie S. Quinn, widow, Lena S. Albaugh, widow, Elwood R. Schildt and Betty L. Schildt, his wife, Gertrude V. Miller and Cecil H. 1. That Emma M. Anders, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, departed this life intestate, on or about the 24th day of May, 1952, seized and possessed of a certain parcel of real estate situate, lying and being in Woodsboro District, Frederick County, Maryland, improved with a dwelling house, barn, and other outbuildings, containing 10 acres, 3 roods, and 25 square purchases of land and more particularly described in a deed from Samuel D. Schildt and Sara C. Schildt, his wife, to Emma L. Eichelberger (who subsequently married Harry T. Anders, and is the Emma M. Anders hereinbefore referred to), which said deed is dated 1st day of April, 1918, and recorded in Liber 324, Folio 379, one of the land records of Frederick County, a certified copy of which said deed is filed herewith marked "Exhibit A", which it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill of Complaint.

2. That the said Emma M. Anders died intestate, as aforesaid, leaving surviving her as her heirs at law, her husband Harry T. Anders, who resides near Woodsboro, in Frederick County, Maryland, and the following brothers and sisters and children of deceased brothers and sisters, to wit:

(a) A sister, Carrie Quinn, who is a widow, and resides in Frederick, Maryland.  
(b) A sister, Lena Albaugh, who is a widow, and resides in Frederick, Maryland.  
(c) A brother, Grant Schildt, residing near Woodsboro, in Frederick County, Maryland.  
(d) The children of a deceased brother, Milton Schildt, all of whom reside in Baltimore, Maryland, and who are as follows:

- (1) Emma Bottrill, whose husband's name is Arthur Bottrill.
- (2) Paul D. Schildt, whose wife's name is Edna M. Schildt.
- (3) Melvin Schildt, whose wife's name is Mary Schildt.
- (4) Charles M. Schildt, unmarried.
- (5) Merle Schildt, unmarried.

(e) The children of Agner Schildt Wagner Bartgis, a deceased sister, who are as follows:

- (1) Ruth Wagner Osborne, whose husband's name is Wilbur Osborne, and who resides in
