The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answer, Exhibits and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered

It is thereupon, this 8th day of August, in the year nineteen hundred and Fifty-one, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold and that Amos A. Holter of Frederick County, be, and he is hereby appointed Trustee to make the said sales, and that the course and manner of his proceedings shall be as follows: he shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court, a BOND to the State of Maryland, executed by him with a surety, or sureties, to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk, thereof, in the penalty of Nineteen Thousand (\$19,000.) Dollars, if given with corporate surety, and Thirty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$38,000.) if given with private sureties, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in \_\_\_\_\_ by this decree, or which may be reposed in him by any future order, or decree in the premises he shall then proceed to make sale of the said Real Estate, having first given at least three weeks previous notice, inserted in some newspaper printed in Frederick County, and such other notice as he may think proper of the
