TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The bill of complaint of Effie Irene Stottlemyer and Frank-
and Helen M. Stottlemyer, his wife
lin H. Stottlemyer, /the above named complainants, respectfully
represents:

1. That a certain Henry Stottlemyer, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, was at the time of his death seized and possessed of certain real estate located near Utica, in Frederick County, Maryland, known as the Home Farm, containing 178 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres of land, more or less, and being the same real estate which is described in two deeds to said Henry Stottlemyer, as follows: The deed from John H. Jamison and wife, dated March 5, 1918, and recorded in Liber No. 328, at folio 547, one of the land records for said Frederick County, conveying 93 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres, more or less, and a certified copy of said deed is filed herewith and marked "Exhibit A," and the deed from Scott Cramer, dated March 5, 1918, and recorded in Liber No. 328, at folio 546, one of said land records, conveying 85 acres, more or less, and a certified copy of said deed is filed herewith and marked "Exhibit B."

2. That being so seized and possessed of said real estate the said Henry Stottlemyer, departed this life, testate, on or about , 1946, leaving a last will and testament,
