THIS DEED made this 5th day of March, in the year nineteen hundred and eighteen, by me, Scott Cromwell, unmarried, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland,

WITNESSETH:- That in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars, and for other valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I, the said Scott Cromwell, do hereby grant and convey, in fee simple, unto Henry Stottlemyer, of the County and State aforesaid, all that parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, as follows; All that farm containing Eighty five acres of land, more or less, adjoining the lands of John Whitmore and others, and being the same real estate which was conveyed to the said Scott Cromwell by George F. Stottlemyer, Henry Stottlemyer and Clarence W. Stottlemyer, Executors of Franklin Stottlemyer, deceased, by deed bearing date of February 22nd, 1918, and intended to be recorded just prior to the recording of this deed, and being also the same real estate which is described in a deed to the said Franklin Stottlemyer from William D. Brengle, Trustee, dated December 22nd, 1896, and recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 14, folio 576, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, aforesaid.

Together with all and singular the buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights ways and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining.
