True Copy of the

Will of

Joshua A. Rice, deceased.

In the name of God, Amen. I Joshua A. Rice of Frederick County, State of Maryland, being sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing mind, considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say:

First and principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executrix hereinafter named, and after my debts and funeral charges are paid, I devise and bequeath as follows:

I give and bequeath to my wife Frances E. all my personal property, the same as held by myself, which she can sell or keep at her own discretion, and I also give and bequeath to her, the said Frances E. all that parcel or tract of land, conveyed to me by deed from the Fredericktown Savings Institution and containing ten acres more or less to have and to hold the same, or to dispose of at her discretion: and I further devise and bequeath to her the said Frances E. any and all money that may remain from the sale of the farm of which I am now possessed after the Mortgage and expenses are paid.

And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my dear wife, Frances E. to be sole Executrix of this my last will and testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament.
