

CODICIL

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. Scott Kefauver, of Frederick County, Maryland, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, to therefore make, publish, declare and ordain the following as and for a codicil to my last will and testament bearing date the 29th. day of July, A.D. 1921;-

I hereby annul and set aside the bequest unto the Central Trust Company of Maryland, a body corporate, in trust, of five shares of stock of the Central Trust Company of Maryland which I then held, in trust that it would pay the dividends which may be from time to time declared upon said stock to the Consistory of the Evangelical Reformed Church of Burkittsville, Maryland, to be used in part payment of the salary of the pastor in charge of said congregation, in memory of myself and my former wife, Ruth E. Kefauver; and as hereinbefore stated this bequest is to be entirely eliminated from my will.

I give, devise and bequeath unto my wife, Mattie E. Kefauver, the house and lot situate at Braddock Heights, Maryland where I now reside, together with the vacant lot belonging to me adjoining my said house and lot, and also all of my furniture and fixtures in said house together with my automobile, to be hers absolutely and unconditionally.

I will and direct that my Executors hereinafter named shall deposit in the Valley Savings Bank, of Middletown, Maryland, in their names as trustees, the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), and that they shall likewise deposit in the Central Trust Company of Maryland the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), the interest on which said sums of money shall be paid semi-annually to my beloved wife, Mattie E. Kefauver for and during the term of her natural life; and after her death I give and bequeath the said sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), as follows:-

To the four children of my deceased nephew, Jacob Rudy, each the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and the balance of the said Ten Thousand Dollars I will and direct shall be divided equally among my nieces and nephews per capita who may be living at the time of my death, and, in the event of anyone of my said nieces or nephews dying prior to the time of distribution, the share or shares of the one so dying shall be paid to their respective heirs at law.
