TESTIMONY TAKEN BEFORE THE COURT, HONORABLE EDWARD S.
DELAPLAINE, August 25, 1942.

EVERETT STULL, Petitioner, produced in his own behalf, be-
ing first duly sworn, deposes and says:

By Mr. Felton:

Q Mr. Stull, will you state your name, please?

A Everett Stull.

Q Where do you live, Mr. Stull? A. Creagerstown.

Q You are a son of Mr. Benton Stull? A. Yes.

Q And a brother to Guy? A. Yes, sir.

Q Mr. Stull, along about the spring of 1941 did your father
ever say anything to you about selling the one farm of 110 acres
to your brother Guy? A. Yes, sir.

Q Will you tell us what he said?

A He told me that he and Guy had agreed that Guy was to buy
the place for the sum of \$8,000, which he agreed to pay.

Q When was that?

A That was sometime prior to the first of April - I don't
know the exact date.

Q In what year? A. 1941.
