First: That Bessie Ceaser died intestate on or about the
 eighth day of December, in the year Nineteen Hundred and Thirty-three,
 seized and possessed of a certain tract of land situate, lying and
 being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, which was conveyed unto
 the said Bessie Ceaser by Jesse E. Toberry and Della M. Toberry, his
 wife, by deed bearing date on the twenty-eighth day of March in the
 year Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-eight and recorded in Liber No. 366,
