May it please your Honorable Court to grant unto your complainant a writ of subpoena against the said Julia Diggs, James Diggs, her husband, residents of Frederick County, State of Maryland, Lula May Ceaser, divorced, who resides at 1502 Mc Cullogh Street, Baltimore City, State of Maryland, commanding them to appear in this court at some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and to abide by and perform any decree as may be passed therein; and may it also please your Honorable Court to grant unto your complainants an order of publication giving notice to the said Harry Ceaser, Clare Ceaser, his wife, residents of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, John Ceaser, Edythe Ceaser, his wife, Charles Ceaser, Lizzie May Ceaser, his wife, Oscar Ceaser, Daisy Ceaser, his wife, all residents of New York City, New York State, of the substance and object of this bill and warning them to appear in this court in person or by solicitor on or before a certain day to answer the premises and show cause, if any, they have why a decree ought not to be passed as prayed.
