

BILL OF COMPLAINT

of the Hon^{ble} the Judge of the Circuit Court
for Frederick County, sitting in Equity:

I humbly complaining sheweth unto
Your Honors Your Orator Charles Manning
and ^{your Orator} Emily Manning, by Charles
Manning, her husband & next friend,
that according to writ: on the 28th day
of April A.D. 1858 the President &
Council of Mount Saint Marys College,
a Corporation, incorporated under the
Laws of this State & empowered by its
Charter to purchase, take hold and
convey in fee simple, real property,
Joshua Clark, Trustee, and Edward
W. Tiers, by deed, dated on the 28th
day of April 1858, and duly recorded
in Liber B. G. F. 192 folio ^{one of}
said records of Frederick County,
conveyed to Your Orator Charles Man-
ning certain real estate lying &
being situate in Dumfries District
in Frederick County, aforesaid, for
the following uses & trusts to wit:

for the term of her natural life,
